RealTime learning is another word for synchronous learning, which is learning that happens live, or in real time. RealTime learning involves using text, video, or voice communication in a way that enables educators and other members of the school to instruct and connect with students in real time.

FlexTime learning is learning that is not delivered in real time or in a synchronous fashion. This may involve students watching pre-recorded video lessons, completing assigned tasks, or contributing to online discussion boards.
