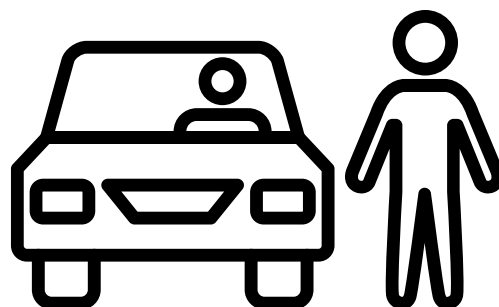
DROP OFF & PICK UP

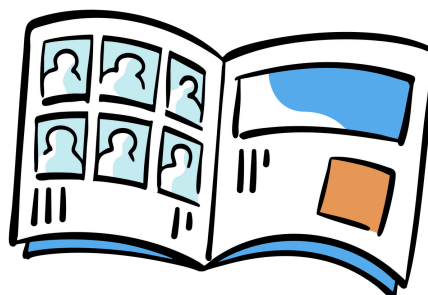
