We hope this letter finds you and your family safe, healthy and well!

We would like to invite you to participate in our Brock High School 2020 Commencement for Grade 12 Graduates on Friday, 9 October 2020 at 1:00 pm. The format of this Commencement will be very different from ceremonies of the past but the importance of this milestone in the lives of our students and families is such that it could not pass unrecognized.

Public Health has indicated that, due to COVID-19 pandemic restrictions, we are not able to host/support indoor groups of more than 50 people at this time. We have decided to undertake a **Drive-Thru/Online Hybrid Commencement Ceremony**.

Structure: Gowns, caps, SHSM stolls and honour cords, which have already been purchased by families, will be delivered to families in advance of the Commencement Day ceremonies.

Students and families will arrive at the Brock High School parking lot, entering at the designated access point (please see diagram on reverse) at the designated time (please refer to the cohorting chart – on reverse).

Family vehicles will progress to the Commencement Area at the Regional Road 12 entrance to the school where students will exit their vehicles to be given their Commencement program, diploma and any possible awards by a member of the Administration team in a socially-distanced, safe manner as approved by the DDSB and Public Health. Families can take photographs of their Graduate from their vehicle. The student will re-enter the vehicle and the family will depart from the designated exit point (please see diagram on reverse).

The online portion of commencement, which will include the speech by our Valedictorian, will occur at 6:00 pm. The link to the online presentation will be forwarded.

Please do respond to the attached RSVP card. Please be assured that students and families who cannot physically attend the drive-thru portion of the ceremony are very welcome to participate in the online portion. We will deliver any diploma, award and program packages to families in a safe, socially-distanced manner after the Commencement date.

Thank you for your support and patience as we continue to work with the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. Our best wishes for future success to all of our Brock High School graduates!
